If any discrepancy is found thereof, IAS JUNIORS reserves the right to disqualify such a participating school at any stage of the contest without prior notice.
- By registering for the IAS JUNIORS ONLINE EXAM, participating school also indicate their acceptance to receive communication that the organisers may send them from time to time regarding the IAS JUNIORS EXAM or other relevant product, offerings or services.

- 2) Appoint School Coordinator To Conduct and Coordinate IAS JUNIORS Exam.
- 3) School Principal / Coordinator Will Receive Username and Password Through WhatsApp / E-Mail.
- 3) Give Circular/Notification (WhatsApp Group Message/Website/ School Circular) about IAS JUNIORS to students.
- 4) Prepare Enrolled Students List, Collect Fees From Students (Students List Must Contain Student Name, Std, Parent's Mobile Number)
- 5) Visit Our Website Again, Using Username and Password, Login and Update Enrolled Students List. Once All Names Typed, Click PAYMENT BUTTON and Pay Total Fees (Rs.500 x Total Number Of Students).
- 6) Once We Receive Students List And Payment, Confirmation Message will be sent to school.
- 7) IAS JUNIORS Free App will be shared to each and every enrolled students with unique username and password.
- 8) Before IAS JUNIORS Exam, Various Notes Will Be Posted In App. Also, Practice tests (Mock Test) will be conducted in IAS JUNIORS App. Through Practice Tests students will get trained with syllabus.
- 9) On Date Slot Chosen By School, IAS JUNIORS ONLINE EXAM Will Be Conducted.
